

Masters Level Therapist – Wraparound with Intensive Services (WISe) Program

Working with the Recovery Model of Care and the System of Care Values and Principles, the WISe Family therapist provides therapy services to up to 10 parents/legal guardians of children and youth enrolled in the Passages' WISe program. The WISe therapist is part of a WISe team and the on-call crisis rotation.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

A. Clinical Services: The WISe Family Therapist will:

1. Master's degree in social work, counseling, or mental health field.
2. Familiarity with the SAMHSA System of Care Values & Principles
3. Provide individual therapy to WISe enrollees
4. Provide family counseling to WISe enrollees
5. Work with the WISe team
6. Insure clinical records are accurate, current, and meet federal and state requirements.
7. Knowledge of HIPAA and Personal Health Information
8. Provide culturally appropriate services
9. Be respectful of youth and family voice, culture, and strengths during all phases of the wraparound process.
